



## Need Help with your Income Tax?

Call our volunteers!

- Income Tax Volunteers are registered, screened and trained by the Canada Revenue Agency (CRA);
- Income Tax Volunteers can file taxes up to 10 years back;
- **You can file your taxes even if you make no income!** By filing taxes you may qualify to receive many government benefits or credits such as the GST/HST credit, the Canada Pension Plan (CPP), the Canada dental benefit, and the Disability tax credit; and
- Finally, appointments go most smoothly if all your receipts are in order when you speak to the income tax volunteer.

*Please understand, the Income Tax Program is designed to help modest income recipients who qualify under the following restrictions:*

- Single people up to \$35,000 annual income; or
- Couples up to \$45,000 annual income; and
- The tax situation must be simple.

There is no fee for this service.

NOTE: Tax filing for 2023 tax returns starts Monday, March 4, 2024. Most tax slips are mailed no later than February 28, 2024, although T3 and T5013 forms do not need to be mailed out until March 31, 2024. Please ensure you have received all your slips before filing.

**DEADLINE:** Tax filing for 2023 ends April 30, 2024.
